Meeting on the unprecedented cholera epidemic occurring in DRC at this time

2017, October 16th - Faced with an unprecedented cholera epidemic which has exceeded a reported 30,000 cases so far this year, primarily in the Eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of Congo, Dr. Ilunga Kalenga, Minister of Health, visited US Government and International agencies in early October seeking financial



2017, April – Initiated by the Veolia Foundation, the programme to fight cholera in the Democratic Republic of the Congo has just passed a critical stage. Following a lengthy preparatory phase, Regideso signed a contract for a three years renovation of the potable water generation and distribution system in the Eastern city of Uvira to greatly reduce the threat of cholera in the City.


