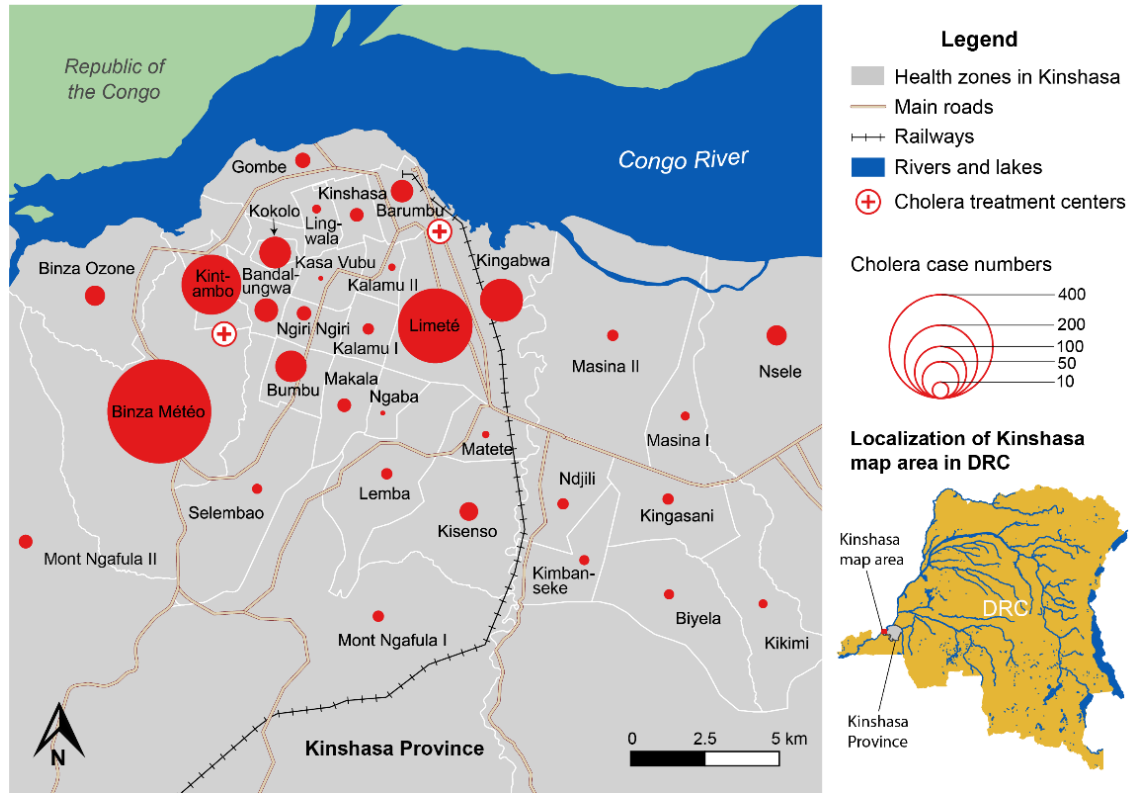

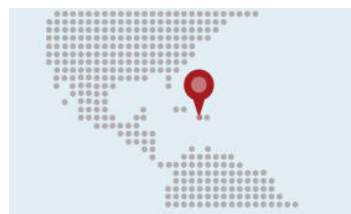
The new targeted WASH response strategy implemented during the cholera outbreak in Kinshasa



During late-2017 in Kinshasa, the capital of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, a cholera outbreak emerged that showed potential to spread throughout the city. In a recent publication in *BMC Infectious Diseases*, Bompangue and colleagues describe a novel targeted water and hygiene response strategy that was implemented to quickly stem the outbreak.

Since 2010, the cholera epidemic in Haiti has resulted in 813,252 suspected cases, including 9,611 deaths, according to the World Health Organization.

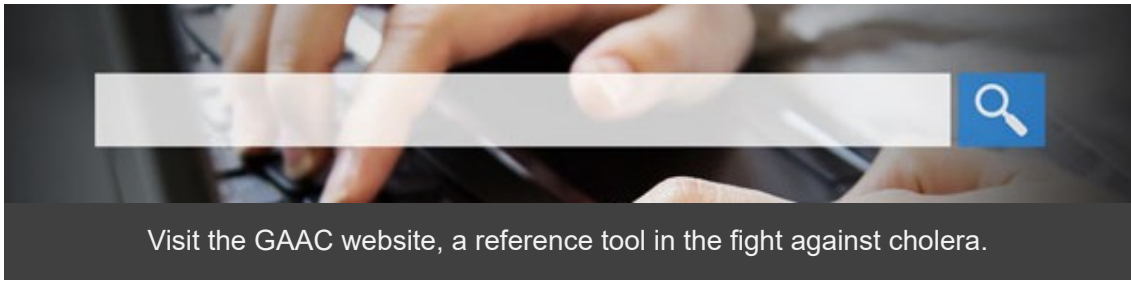
